- I. Call Meeting to Order: Mrs. Roessler called the meeting to order at 9:00 PM.
- II. Citizens' Comments:
 - a. On agenda items: None.
 - b. On non-agenda items: John Anderson - Mr. Anderson spoke in regards to extracurricular activities and student involvement in programs and positive outlooks for the PBSB.
- III. Agenda Action Items: None.
- IV. Agenda Discussion Items:
 - a. Security Cameras:
 1. Dr. Glasspool informed the Board that the tentative cost for replacing and modifying cameras throughout the District would be \$150,000-\$200,000. The Board wishes to pursue this venture and pursue bids.
 - b. Policy 824 - Junior High School:
 1. Mr. Fishell spoke to the junior high body about Policy 824, but not in its entirety. Full-scale training will be in stages and forthcoming.
 - c. AM Procedures at the High School:
 1. Mr. Kociela is monitoring AM procedures at the high school due to traffic congestion.

- d. Morning Arrival Procedures for Each School:
 - 1. Procedures are in place at each school.
- e. Narcan:
 - 1. Narcan is at the pharmacy and will need to be retrieved and placed in the schools.
- f. Access Pads and Fobs:
 - 1. Mr. Holleran discussed the cost of installing access pads (\$3,561 for each pad). The Facilities Department will assess the need for additional pads.
- g. Safety Committees at Each School:
 - 1. Formalized safety committees will be discussed at the next Safe and Supportive Schools meeting.
- h. Safety Programs in Other Districts:
 - 1. Limited responses were obtained from the AIU in regards to safety programs in other districts.
- i. Status of Policy 824 Training on the Website:
 - 1. The District will be conducting additional trainings on Policy 824. Ultimately, the training will be uploaded to the new HR platform.
- j. RFP - Comprehensive Safety Study:
 - 1. A general RFP will be advertised for a comprehensive safety study.
- k. ALICE Training:
 - 1. Dr. Glasspool discussed the two options for ALICE training with the Board. Option 1 was chosen to implement.
- l. GMAIL Applications for Coaches:
 - 1. Mrs. Roesler spoke about the possibility of having coaches obtain a GMAIL application for their phones.
- m. Beautification Program:
 - 1. Mrs. Roesler spoke about a new High School marquee and reaching out to organizations/clubs to assist and adopt areas around the District to help beautify our campuses.
- n. Safety Coordinator:
 - 1. The Board was advised that a newly revised job description was uploaded for their review.

o. AWAREITY Update:

1. Mr. Brewer provided the Board with an update on AWAREITY.

p. Climate Survey:

1. The Board discussed the possibility of initiating a climate survey and reviewed the documents and costs (\$8,875) associated with implementing a survey form the National Climate Survey Center. At this time, it was decided not to pursue the cost of initiating a survey from the National Climate Survey Center.
