- Mental Health First Aid - Admin & targeted staff
- CPR/AED/First Aid/*Stop the Bleed* - Faculty, Admin, Paraprofessionals, Bus Drivers, etc...
- ALICE - Students, Parents, newly hired professional staff
- *The Reality Tour* - Students & Parents
- Parent Forums 2017-2018



# SCHOOL ENVELOPE SECURITY

- Concentric Circles or Layered Security
- School entrance & doors
- Metal detectors
- Residents use of property
- Dogs on school property
- Restricted access to property



- Metal Detectors - Schools, events, type, etc...
- Main Entrance - Reconfigure PHS & Regency Park
- Residents using property - walking property/campus, tennis courts, etc...
- Dogs on school property - policy & enforcement
- Restricted access to property - lockable gates, guard station, policy, etc...

# SCHOOL PRACTICES

- Student/School Drills
- Student supervision & threat mitigation
- District communication
- Law enforcement response

**ALICE**<sup>®</sup>  
TRAINING INSTITUTE

**ALERT**  
Initial Alert may be a gunshot, PA announcement, etc...  
Avoid code words.

**LOCKDOWN**  
If Evacuation is not a safe option, barricade entry points.  
Prepare to Evacuate or Counter if needed.

**INFORM**  
Communicate real time information on shooter location.  
Use clear and direct language using any communication means possible.

**COUNTER**  
As a last resort, distract shooters ability to shoot accurately.  
Move toward exits while making noise, throwing objects,  
or adults swarm shooter.

**EVACUATE**  
Run from danger when safe to do so using non-traditional exits if necessary. Rallying point should be predetermined.

- One (1) student Drill per month, per school (9 months)
  - 2 Fire Drills
  - 2 Bus Evacuation Drills
  - 2 Lock Down Drills
  - 2 School Evacuation Drills
  - 1 Severe Weather Drill

# PHS STUDENT SUPERVISION & THREAT MITIGATION

- PHS - 295,404 sq. feet on 42 acres
  - Move or add cameras - currently 125 cameras
  - Custodian schedule modification to secure and check bathrooms between every period
    - 8 sets of bathrooms & 4 sets of locker rooms


