




Traffic will be detoured for 75 days.


#### Car Detour

- Coxcomb Hill Road/Hulton Road (Route 2082), Freeport Road/Pittsburgh Street (Route 1001), Schmidt Bridge (Route 1038), Route 56, and Industrial Boulevard (Route 4087).
