# Draft Extracurricular Activities Fees

Plum School District

2012-13 School Year

An activity fee will be in effect for the 2012-13 school year for extracurricular activities. The following guidelines will be utilized:

- A fee of \$75 per student will be charged with a family cap of \$225 per family.
- Participation fees are due one week prior to the first contest/activity/performance. Failure to pay will result in exclusion.
- Fees should be paid by cash, check or money order payable to the Plum Borough School District Activity Fund.
- No refunds will be given for a student who becomes academically ineligible, is removed for disciplinary reasons or for students who quit the sport/activity after the fee has been paid.
- Payment of an activity fee does not guarantee playing time.
- Students/booster groups will have the option of participating in a fund raising activity to earn funds to pay their activity fee.
- If a financial hardship exists, the parent/guardian is required to provide a brief written explanation of the circumstances and submit this to the \_\_\_\_\_.
