247	Hazing	"The updated PSBA policy guide includes a revised definition for hazing and adds a definition for student activity or organization. The law requires adoption of appropriate penalties that may include the imposition of fines; the withholding of diplomas or transcripts, pending compliance with the rules or pending payment of fines; and the imposition of probation, suspension, dismissal or expulsion. The policy is drafted to refer to the school entity's Code of Student Conduct to ensure consistency in the recommendation of appropriate disciplinary action/penalties. Please review the optional language related to the imposition of fines and the withholding of diplomas and/or transcripts and choose the options, including designating dollar amounts, that best correspond with your school entity operations." <i>(PSBA Policy News Network)</i>
