III. Agenda Action Items Discussions:

- 1. **Treasurer's Report:** Approve Treasurers' Report for the Month of April 2016. Report will be sent electronically to board members prior to the meeting for their review.
- 2. Homestead/Farmstead Exclusion Resolution. Recommend adoption of a Resolution authorizing the Homestead/Farmstead Exclusion real estate assessment reduction for the school district's fiscal year tax invoices beginning July 1, 2016 under the provisions of the Taxpayers Relief Act (Act 1 of 2006), as attached. The Exclusion lowers qualified real estate tax taxpayer's 2016 property assessment by \$10,908.00 and the tax invoice by \$211.00. District will receive \$1,653,351.03 in gaming revenues to be divided by 7,822 qualified applicants. Copy of Resolution is attached.
- 3. **2016-17 Insurances.** Recommend authorizing AJ Gallagher (Gleason Division) to bind insurance coverage for the 2016-17 fiscal year with the Cyber Liability Coverage added, as presented.

- 5. Discuss 2016-17 Preliminary Budget impact items as follows:
 - 1. "Scoop" Refinancing Option to defer debt service obligation / PlanCon reimbursement
 - 2. Discuss (new) "PSERS" Refinancing Option to defer pension costs (in lieu of "Scoop")
 - 3. Tax Increase to Act 1 Index (+.619 mills) or (3.3% increase)
 - 4. Integration of building and associated cost reductions
 - 5. Review non-required courses listing. Elementary and Secondary
 - 6. Discuss effect of changes in graduation requirements
 - 7. Discuss shortening of educational school days at High School (900 hour school year requirement)
 - 8. Discuss purchasing and financing options for purchasing eight school buses new or slightly used buses. Currently, \$80,000 is budgeted as annual debt service payment for new buses in 2016-17 in account 10-5110-911.
 - 9. Discuss allowable uses for remaining proceeds (\$371,111.32) in Fund 34 Series E 2013 Bond Issue. Mr. Cliff Pastel confirmed with Mr. Marraccini proceeds must be spent only on capital assets with 20 or more year useful life.
 - Example for allowable usage is renovations at bus garage buildings on Greensburg Road or reimbursement to 2014 Bond Issue payments for building improvement at bus garage buildings.
 - 10. General Fund (10) available funds. As of this date, District's Fund 10 investments and checking equates to \$801,945 after making the 5/13/16 payroll and May's health insurance premium payable and outstanding invoices. Additional State revenues or a draw from the S&T TRAN will be needed to meet the 5/31/16 payroll obligations (wages and payroll taxes). To date, District has not been notified of any upcoming subsidy distributions.
 - 11. Official adoption of the 2016-17 General Fund Budget (Fund 10) is scheduled for May 24, 2016. Adopted building will be on displayed until scheduled adoption of Final Budget on June 30, 2016.
