Agenda Items:

- 1. Borough ordinance forgiving real estate taxes for active military
 - a. The Borough's solicitor said the enabling legislation would not permit the Borough or District to forgive real estate taxes for our active military.

2. <u>PHS fire lane</u>

- a. A meeting between the Borough and District Administration is scheduled for May 14th to discuss a parking ordinance creation and installation options for eco-friendly parking using impervious coverage. The Borough and District will craft an ordinance for a targeted enforcement area in the rear of the building near the tennis court loop. High School Administration will develop a plan to notify students and staff about the new enforcement area.
- 3. Holiday and Regency Park on street parking concern
 - a. Updated school zone safety plan may be necessary. The discussion on an updated school safety zone around each school is an option may be discussed on May 14th. A traffic engineer from PA DOT may be involved in the process. The Borough will provide the District with copies of existing plans.

4. Water shut-offs, tap-in, and turn-ons

a. The Borough planning department will assist Dr. Stewman with the aggregation of necessary information to conduct his study. The Borough assisted Dr. Stewman in prior years with information.

Other Consideration:

- 1. Mr. Colella discussed ideas about curtailing speeding down Elicker and New Texas Roads shortly after the school day. The Borough will speak with Chief Monaco and look into options; ie. ticketing, targeted enforcement, police presence, and mobile stations.
- 2. The Borough switched its employees to an HSA and saved \$300,000. Mr. Dell and Mr. Dowdell brought this information to the Board as a cost savings measure for the District to consider. The Borough will share HSA plan information with District.
