- 1. Construction Updates
 - a. The new Public Works building is complete and occupied. The Borough is developing the building footprint for the EMS site and working on the road extension. The EMS facility is anticipating occupancy by March 1, 2014.
 - b. New Holiday Park Elementary School is progressing well. The building is on schedule and on budget.
 - c. The potential of a new Regency Park Elementary School building project was discussed. The School Board is expecting a decision in the near future on renovation or new construction.
 - i. The Millers Lane paving and sidewalk project was discussed.
 - 1. The Turnpike Commission will replace the bridge crossing over Millers Lane. At this time, the PA DOT is unable to provide the timeline.
 - 2. The Borough will consider a new traffic study and/or school safety study for Regency Park.
 - d. The possibility of new Transportation Facility and snow removal concerns were discussed.
 - e. A joint project for a multi-purpose field on School Road was discussed. Conversation will continue in Council and Borough committee meetings.
- 2. The Plum Borough Comprehensive Safety Structure
 - a. A progress report and update occurred. Additional discussion about painted "white lines" on roadways was discussed. The "white lines" are fog lines. These "white lines" delineate the end of the cart ways and are not for walking purposes.
