Agenda Items:

1. Construction Updates
 - a. Public Works Building on Renton Road
The borough provided an update that highlighted steel erection and site improvements.
 - b. New Elementary School Project at 313 Holiday Park Drive
The District update included the overall scope of the project including the demolition of Adlai Stevenson, student transition to "Old" Pivik, and the design development of a new elementary school on the Oblock campus located at 313 Holiday Park Drive. Conversation concerning the School Road traffic occurred. The Borough and District administration will investigate the School Road traffic options in the months to come.

2. PHS Fire Lane/Parking
 - a. Additional parking spaces & parking bollards
The project will be completed in a few weeks.
 - b. Tow away zone
The committee discussed options and requirements of a tow away zone. No decision was made at the meeting.
 - c. Borough ordinance permitting ticketing
Borough will move to adopt an ordinance in February or March. Enforcement will commence following project completion, new signage installation and parking bollard placement. Tickets issued to violators could be \$5.00, the

current rate, or possibly higher. The Borough will consider a higher rate at their next meeting.

3. Plum Borough Comprehensive Safety Structure
 - a. A progress report on the newly developed safety structure occurred. The committee has finalized its purpose, parameters, projects and education of overall student safety ranging from transportation, walking to and from school, and emergency response and mitigation.
 - b. A brief conversation about school zone studies at PHS, Oblock and Center occurred.

4. Oakmont Country Club property reassessment
The Borough and District will collaborate on the property owners' reassessment appeal.

5. Real-estate Tax Collector
The Borough proposed changes for the shared cost for computers and software. The taxing entities, the Borough and District, will provide the Tax Collector with software and equipment thereby granting electronic access of data to the taxing entities.
