

Kindergarten Supply List

As we prepare for the 2022-23 school year, we have compiled a list of supplies that will be needed for Kindergarten. Each child will need their own supplies so that we can continue to help our students explore, create, build, and learn with hands-on materials. Students will be provided with a box of crayons and scissors from the school.

The following items will be needed to to travel back and forth with your child each day and each item should be labeled with your child's first and last name:

1. Backpack large enough to hold the following supplies:
2. Hard plastic pencil box (dimensions: 8 5/8" x 5 3/4" x 2 1/2)
3. 1-inch binder with clear customizable cover (write your child's name on the spine of the binder)
4. zippered fabric pencil pouch attached to the inside of the 3-ring binder
5. Over ear headphones (please write their name on them in Sharpie) and place in a ziploc baggie inside of bookbag
6. Extra change of clothes (underwear, shorts, shirt) in a ziploc baggie to be kept in your child's bookbag.
7. A leak-proof thermos filled with water

Please include only the following items in your child's plastic pencil box:

- o 10 pencils, sharpened
- o 3-5 Elmer's glue sticks (we'll keep some in our pencil box and collect the extras until they are needed)
- o pack of fine-tipped black dry erase markers (5 markers)

****Please send only the designated items on the supply list. Do not send notebooks, markers, crayons, colored pencils, or glitter glue.**

The following items are things that will be used throughout the year with all of the students. They are not mandatory, however, if you would like to donate one or any of the following it would be greatly appreciated:

- Antibacterial wipes
- Ziploc sandwich sized slider baggies
- Ziploc snack size baggies
- Ziploc quart sized slider baggies
- Ziploc gallon sized slider baggies
- Hand sanitizer
- White paper plates
- Roll of paper towels
