1. Purpose

The Board recognizes its responsibility to the district taxpayers of the to be ensure that public monies expended by the school district are utilized for delivery of the furtherance of public educational program in a manner that will ensure mandates full value to the taxpayers, and that adequate constraints procedures and records are established to ensure that end.

2. Authority

The Board has the authority and responsibility to prepare <u>and adopt</u> the budget, approve bids, <u>levy taxes</u>, <u>approve</u> and <u>pass upon</u> each expenditure of the district, <u>and incur debt in accordance with law</u>.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The district shall submit an annual financial report to the Secretary of Education by October 31 of each year, in accordance with law and the reporting standards established by the Pennsylvania Department of Education.

To meet the goals of this policy, the Board requires directs the Superintendent and the Business Manager or his/her designee to establish sound accounting procedures:

based upon State and Federal recommended accounting procedures;

based upon the recommendations of the district auditor and state and federal government, institute effective business practices, and

recommend <u>appropriate</u> <u>suitable accounting</u> equipment <u>and technology when</u> <u>where</u> necessary.

The Business Manager shall prepare the following monthly reports for the Finance Committee: review monthly the financial operations monthly and

- 1. Revenues versus plan
- 2. Expenditures versus plan
- 3. Variances to revenue and expenditure plans
- 4. Listing of bills paid since last report
- 5. Budgetary transfers and reason(s)
- 6. Finance Committee action items and status

The Business Manager shall report to the Board on the effectiveness of the business policies and procedures and recommended improvements, and prepare administrative <u>regulations</u> and procedures for sound district and school fiscal operations for adoption by the Board.
