Optional iPad Insurance

Insurance is available for all iPads that are part of the District's 1:1 iPad program. Students who purchase insurance after receiving an iPad must have the iPad visually inspected by Technology Media Center staff in order to verify the device is not damaged at the time of insurance purchase. Insurance will cover the instructional school year, from date of inspection after purchase until the end of school in June. The annual cost for iPad insurance is \$40 per iPad per year.
