If you would like for us to obtain pricing for natural gas, we can do that for you. We will contact you when we receive our pricing and if you want to participate, we will be able to work that out. Pricing for natural gas will start September 2015 for a one, two or three year period.

During the past months the Western Pennsylvania Natural Gas Consortium Committee has been monitoring the natural gas market to determine if there was an opportunity to obtain a lower basis price (transportation) for natural gas for our members.

The natural gas market has dropped to a point where attractive pricing for the transportation or "basis" cost may be obtained for a one, two or three year agreement. The NYMEX Plus Basis (supply) pricing is comprised of the commodity cost and the transportation or "basis" cost for delivering your natural gas to your utility company.

We have been very successful in obtaining competitive pricing by your continued participation in the Western Pennsylvania Natural Gas Consortium and have saved the 116 participating districts over \$2.3 million dollars for the 2012-13 fiscal year. The combination of school districts from IU#1, IU#3, IU#4, IU#7, IU#8, IU#19, IU#27 and IU#28 provides us with leverage when securing proposals from suppliers. Because of our continued success we have been asked to present at the 2014 National School Boards Conference on "How to use the Power of a Consortium to Purchase Fuel and Energy."
